An MDT meeting is held usually weekly at the Hospice on a Tuesday.

This meeting gives the specialists involved in your care the opportunity to discuss and coordinate your treatment on an individual basis. This is to ensure you are offered the most appropriate treatment for your illness.

The outcomes of these meetings will be communicated to you verbally by the health care professional who is involved in your care. You can obtain a copy of the written MDT meeting discussion and outcomes should you wish to receive one.

It may become appropriate for patients approaching end of life to be put on an individual plan of care. The End of Life Care Plan Working Document (see separate download) is introduced to document an individual plan of care and support for patients at the end of life.
