Getting there



You can park at the Tesco Extra car park next to the stadium for free.



The Halliwell Jones Stadium is a short walk away from Warrington Central Train Station and the Bus Station.



We encourage you to use public transport or car share where possible.



Entry will be via the South Concourse 'Jack Fish Corner' on Buckley Street. Please head to Brian Bevan Statue and marshals will direct you from here.

Timings

18:30- Registration opens in the South Concourse.

19:50- Warm up with PT Sharon Bannister.

20:00-5k walk starts.

20:45-21:30- Cross the finish line!

21:00-22:30- Whitney Houston Tribute Act, bar open!

23:00- Event finish.

When you arrive

- ✓ On arrival, please ensure you sign in and collect your t-shirt and walk number (if not already collected in advance).
- ✓ Once registered, you can browse the merchandise on offer, get your glitter face paint for £3 per face and enjoy the 80's themed music.
- ✓ There will also be a food kiosk selling refreshments, hot dogs, sausage rolls and pies if you wish to eat before the walk (Card Only).
- ✓ If you pre-ordered your merchandise to be collected on the day, this will be available to collect from the registration point on arrival.
- ✓ There will be an opportunity to dedicate a lantern in memory of a loved one for a donation of £5. These will be on display at the Brian Bevan statue on your return from the walk.



The Route

Start: Halliwell Jones Stadium
1k: End of Bridge Street
2k: Bank Quay Train Station
3k: Bewsey Road
4k: Lockey Bridge
Finish: Back at Halliwell Jones Stadium

We will have a number of volunteer marshals along the route who are there to direct and cheer you on. Please be advised that our marshals cannot stop traffic and it is your responsibility to cross all roads safely using pedestrian lights where possible and following the **Green Cross Code**.

Important Information



Please make sure you sign in, are wearing your walker number and official neon night walk t-shirt.



Please stick to the planned route. Although we will have marshals to direct, we will provide you with a map and directions as well.



Please don't drink alcohol while participating in the walk.



First aiders will be based at the stadium and will also be out on the route. You can seek medical help or any assistance by phoning the number on the next page. Alternatively, you can alert your nearest marshal.



A reminder that children aged 15 and under must be accompanied by a registered adult (18+) at all times.
