- The evening begins with a drink's reception at 6:00pm
- Please be advised that each table will have a tablet for ordering drinks directly from the table. You will be seated at 6:45pm for the welcome and speeches, followed by a two-course dinner at 7.15pm and tea, coffee and mince pies.
- At 8.45pm our 8 amateur dancers will perform alongside their professional dance partner, and you'll have the chance to vote for your favourite
- When the votes have been counted and combined to the judges' scores, we'll reveal the winner of Strictly St. Rocco's 2025.
- After that, the dance floor will be open for you to enjoy the rest of the evening and the bar will remain open until 12am.

Please note that the dancers will be in the Green Room getting ready, until after the dance performances have taken place.

The event will be live streamed on Facebook three times throughout the evening. The speeches (from 18:45), dance performances (from 20:45) and results (from 22:30). Any friends or family that are not able to be at the event can watch here and place their vote by text to donate once all dance performances have taken place.
